SAGE is a unique graduate programme from Jubilee Centre, one of the UK's leading Christian think tanks.

Graduates spend a year with us, in Cambridge, learning to think biblically about issues in public life, develop research skills and mobilise other Christians around a social reform objective.

## WHAT ARE THE MAIN OUTCOMES?

- Discover the Bible's social vision and how it addresses 21st century issues in public life
- Embrace a framework for Christian social reform based on Relational Thinking
- Learn how and why to ground social transformation initiatives on thorough research
- Develop skills for biblical and issue-based research and for communication of ideas
- Form and implement a strategy for engaging Christian leaders around a specific issue
- Grow in personal, social and spiritual maturity

## HOW IS SAGE STRUCTURED?

**Study Phase (October to Christmas):** You'll learn about how the Bible provides both the foundations and objectives for engaging in public life. Modules include the economy, politics, law and justice, family and sexual ethics, welfare, the arts and science & technology.

**Research Phase (Christmas to Easter):** developing biblical and issue-based research skills as you carry out an in-depth investigation as a team into one specific issue in public life.

**Engagement Phase (Easter to July):** You will turn your research findings into appropriate outputs (e.g. publication, film or workshop) which you will use to equip and mobilise Christian leaders and wider audiences.

## DETAILS

**WHO IS IT FOR?** SAGE is for recent graduates who have mature Christian character and leadership potential.

**LOCATION?** The programme is based in Jubilee Centre's office in central Cambridge.

### WHERE DO PARTICIPANTS LIVE?

The five participants selected to join the programme live together in the SAGE house in Cherry Hinton, a suburb of Cambridge, which is a 15 minute cycle ride from the Jubilee Centre offices.

### WHAT DOES IT COST?

The full fees for the 2019/20 SAGE programme are £5,800 but each participant receives a scholarship of £4,000 (leaving £1,800 to fundraise). You will also need around £450/month for accommodation and bills, and up to £200/month for food, transport (a bicycle is highly recommended) and other living expenses.
